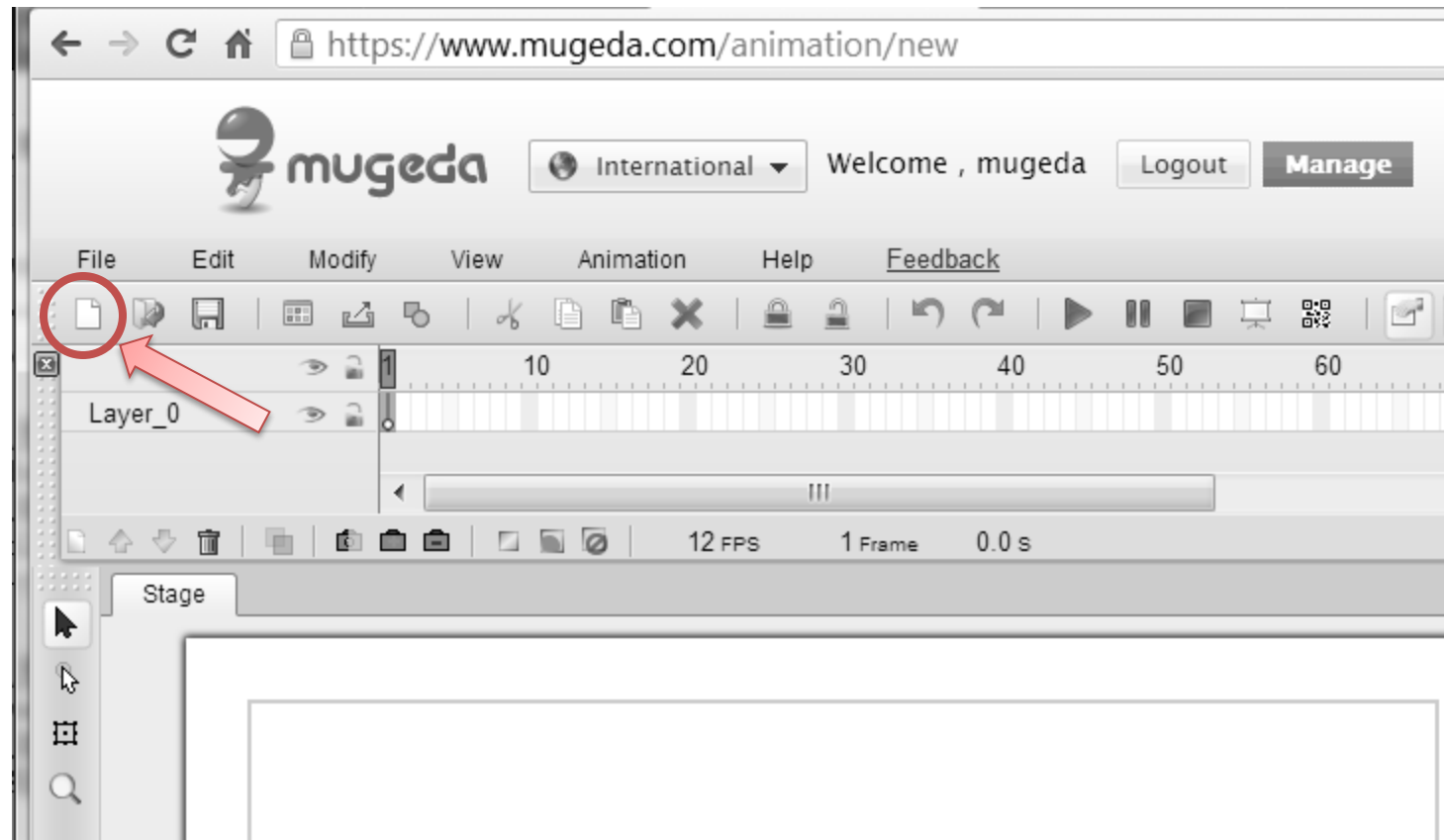

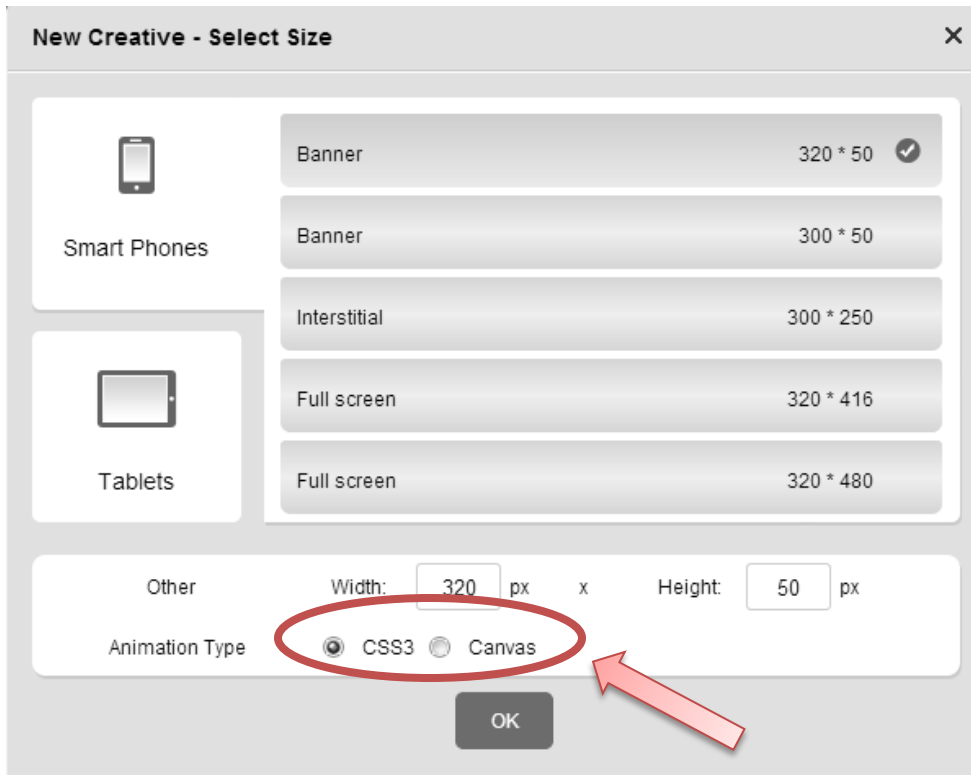
Animation Type

CSS3 or Canvas

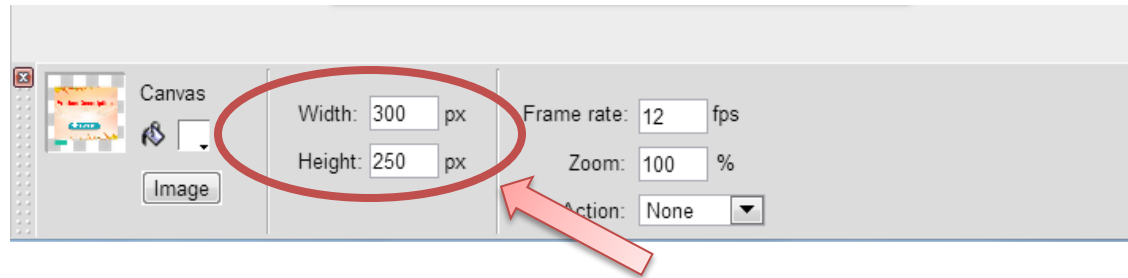


CSS3 and Canvas are two alternative ways to create HTML5 animations.

More details regarding CSS3 and Canvas will be explained in a separate tutorial.

If you don't know the difference, generally CSS3 will be sufficient for regular purposes, and recommended.

Changing Size



If you change your mind after the size is chosen, you may always edit the content size in the property dialog. Make sure there is no element is selected on the stage so that the property for the stage is displayed.
